Title and abstract of the doctoral thesis**Title and abstract of the doctoral thesis (within 150 words)****History of the Modes of Reading (al-qira'at al-qur'aniyyah)**

This study aims to provide a more accurate reading and understanding of the history of the Qur'anic modes of reading (qira'at). It provides an in-depth examination of their first phase in the earliest days and their development throughout their history up until the time of the famous reciter Ibn al-Jazari. The current study shows that the modes of reading were learned from Prophet Muhammad and that the companions transmitted them, or at least some of them, to the next generation. Moreover, the research examines certain events which directly affected the qira'at such as the death of many of the reciters in the Apostasy War during the caliphate of Abu Bakr and the dispute amongst people from different regions during the caliphate of ʿUthman. Also, this study reflects and sheds light on the contributions of the most influential reciters Ibn Mujahid, al-Dani, and Ibn al-Jazari.
