:Abstract

This thesis consists of an introduction, a preliminary chapter, five chapters, and a conclusion

The introduction discusses the significance of the research topic, its objectives, the scope and limits of the study, and the methodology adopted in conducting the research

The preliminary chapter is devoted to defining the Companions (may Allah be pleased with them) and is divided into six sections

Chapter One examines the differences concerning the establishment of Companionship due to defining its concept and the criteria for affirming it. This chapter is divided into eleven sections

Chapter Two addresses the differences concerning the establishment of Companionship arising from narration and transmission, and it comprises six sections

Chapter Three discusses the differences concerning the establishment of Companionship due to illusion and error, and it consists of eleven sections

Chapter Four is dedicated to explaining the differences concerning the establishment of Companionship based on contextual indicators related to Companionship

Chapter Five focuses on the methods used by scholars who authored works on the Companions in inferring and weighing evidence for affirming or negating Companionship in cases of disputed status. This chapter is divided into eight sections

The thesis concludes with a conclusion summarizing the most significant findings of the research, followed by a set of technical indexes
