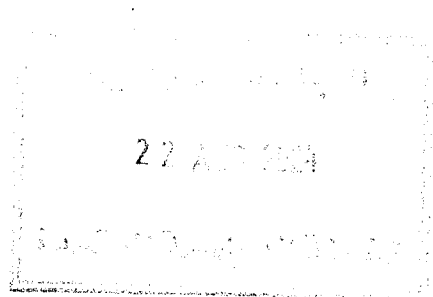

**Course Description**

This course deals with an in-depth study of the subject of crimes in Islamic jurisprudence, in terms of definition and sections, and a study of murder and its sections. Intentional murder, its definition and elements, semi-intentional murder, its definition and elements, manslaughter, its definition, types and elements, retaliation, its contraindications and how to fulfil it, the forfeiture of retaliation, its expiry, alternative punishments for murder of all kinds.

Felonies against what is less than the life, intentionally or wrongly, and their elements, the reasons for refraining from retaliation for what is less than the life, the conditions for applying retaliation in this type of crime, its fulfilment, its lapse, and the alternative punishments for it, the crime against what is the soul in a way other than the other, the crime against the fetus and its miscarriage, and what is related to it.

**Prerequisite: ()**

**Course Description**

This course deals with the topics of marriage and divorce with an in-depth, specialized jurisprudential study and comparison with the Jordanian Personal Status Law through an introductory introduction to the Jordanian Personal Status Law, the areas it covers, the principles upon which it is based, and the history of this law and its amendments. Then the course also addresses the topics of the jurisprudence of marriage: from marriage and its preliminaries, such as the engagement, the marriage contract, and its conditions. Guardianship, competence, and prohibitions, then types of marriage and their provisions, documenting the contract and stipulations in it, then the effects of the contract such as dowry, marital maintenance, and housing. Then, the issue of dissolution of the marriage contract from a waiting period, waiting period maintenance, arbitrary divorce, and the rights of children and relatives such as lineage, breastfeeding, custody, and expenses for children, parents, and relatives will be addressed.
