Course Description
MASTER IN (FAITH)

- 0401761 The Doctrine of Divinity and Predestination (3cr)**
Includes studying monotheism and methodologies of proving the existence of God Almighty, believing in the predestination and opinions of scholars in this regard, the scholars' viewpoints regarding deeds of human beings, the subject of guidance and misguidance and God's will in the universe.
- 0401762 The Doctrine of Prophethood and Hereafter (3cr)**
Includes studying the phenomenon of revelation, proving the Prophethood, miracles, infallibility, sealing of Prophethood and believing in prophets and messengers.
- 0401763 The Heavenly Religions (3cr)**
Includes studying legislations, history, teachings, thoughts, worships, holydays and sects in Judaism and Christianity. This study will be compared with Islam.
- 0401764 Sects and Faith Schools of Thought (3cr)**
Includes studying Islamic faith schools of thought which have appeared during different ages, their impact on Islamic society till our time, such as Kharigites, Shi'ats, Mo'tazilatis and Ahl-Assohah.
- 0401765 Logic and Research Methodology (3cr)**
Includes studying the definition of logic and the history of logical studies and their development in the Islamic thought and what was the attitudes of Muslim scholars towards them. It deals also with the methodologies of research and writings in the Islamic Faith and Philosophical studies.
- 0401766 The Theory of Epistemology in Islam (3cr)**
Includes studying the concept of the theory of epistemology and its status in the mentality of the religious and philosophical thinking and the origins of this theory in the Qur'an and the Sunnah.
- 0401767 Islam and Philosophy (3cr)**
Includes studying the concept and history of philosophy, the most important schools in ancient philosophy, Islamic philosophy, the middle ages philosophy and modern philosophy.

- 0401768 Contemporary Schools of Thought (3cr)**
Includes studying the circumstances which have prepared for the spreading of the material thought in Europe, the conflict between the Church and the science, the French revolution, and the specific role that has been played by Jews in this regard. This course should discuss Secularism, Globalization, Communism, Rationalism, Existentialism, Pragmatism, Masons and Zionism in light of Islamic critique.
- 0401769 The None - Heavenly Religions (3cr)**
Includes the history of the None – Heavenly Religions from the ancient times to the present. It studies the big issues in Zoroastrian, Hinduism, Buddhism, in terms of their doctrines, legislations, teachings, thoughts, worships and holydays. This study compared with Islam.
- 0401770 Textual studies from the Books of Monotheism (3cr)**
Includes studying a selected materials from the Islamic faith books such as: Definition of faith, its borders and what contradicts with it, attributes of God Almighty, belief in the destiny, the infallibility of prophets and the relation between God and his attributes.
- 0401771 Methodologies of Scholars of Monotheism (3cr)**
Includes the methodologies of Islamic thought theology and general logical roots amongst the schools of monotheism. It investigates the thought and viewpoints which have been raised from these schools. It concentrates on the following schools; Mo'tazilites, Salafi and Asha'irites.
- 0401772 Faith in the Qur'an and the Sunnah (3cr)**
Includes the dogmatic speech in the Qur'an, and studying subjects in Islamic faith from the Qur'an and the Sunnah such as: monotheism, belief, destiny, names and attributes of God Al-mighty and the Hereafter.
- 0401773 Issues in Islamic Sects (3cr)**
Includes the most important issues in the Moslems' sects , such as: Leadership, Justice, Monotheism, Belief and Disbelief ,Al-Raj'ah and Sealed of Prophecy . This study will be in light of the Qu'ran and The Sunnah.
- 0401774 The Science of Ethics and Sufism (3cr)**
Includes studying the science of ethics and its relation with the theory of values and its status in Islam, studying the ethical theories of the great Muslim intellectuals and the relation between ethics and Sufism.
- 0401705 The Inimitability of the Holy Qur'an (3cr)**
Includes studying the meaning of the word "inimitability" literally and as a specific term in Islam, the development of writing in the field, highlighting the aspects of inimitability in the Holy Qur'an. In addition it deals with some of the doubts and

suspicious that have been raised against the Holy Qur'an both in the past and in the modern times.

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- 0401737 **Mukhtalif al-Hadith (what appears contradicted superficially)** (3cr)
Includes studying the concept of Mukhtalif al-Hadith (superficial contradiction in Hadith) literally and as a term. It discusses the reasons for real dispute and what appears as a dispute although it is not, and the methodologies of Muslim scholars in dealing with this issue.
