MASTER in EXEGESIS

- 0431701 Qur'anic Sciences (3 Cr. H.)**
This course deals with various elements, following are some of them: The origins, importance and branches of this science, translation of the Qur'an, abrogation in the Qur'an: its meaning, its actuality, the exaggeration in accepting abrogation and discussing some verses which are said to be abrogated, the Meccan and Medinan Qur'an, the 7 *ahruf*: the meaning, their relationship to the variations, idea of abrogating them and the change in the spellings of the words, inimitability of the Qur'an: the concept and the forms, dialogue in the Qur'an, and *muhkam and Mutashabi*.
- 0401702 Textual Study on Books of Exegesis (3 Cr. H.)**
By studying and analyzing chosen texts from the books of Qur'anic exegesis, this course aims to help the student to learn how to read and analyze the original sources of this subject, to reveal the deviant methodologies in exegesis and how to reveal issues in the text relevant to creed and belief system. The course also aims to clarify the inimitability of the Qur'an and its aspects, linguistic style of the Qur'an, the Qur'anic methodology of guidance, the perfection in chosen the Qur'anic phrase and how to connect between its sentences and verses. This course aims also to concentrate on chosen texts in different exegesis books and help the student in dealing with contemporary issues and how to deal with them from Qur'anic perspective.
- (0431703) Methodologies of Exegets (3 Cr. H.)**
This course introduces the student to the definition of (exegesis), its importance, conditions, types, and the difference between Tafseer and Taweel. It defines the traditional exegeses, its importance, and the reasons behind the weakness of it. The importance of exegesis by Ra'y. The course also aims to introduce the Commentators' manners of interpretation in their books, and to throw light on their terms and expressions, and how can their knowledge and circumstances effect their manners.
- (0401704) Analytic Exegesis (3 Cr. H.)**
This course deal with the analytical methodology in interpreting the Qur'an and its features. During the course the student will study chapter (8 Al-Anfal), and chapter (22 Al-Nur); the words, phrases, sentences, focusing on stylish features, metaphor, interrelation between verses, jurisprudential and other issues in each chapter. With taking into account the differences in subject and style.
- (0401705) The Inimitability of The Holy Qur'an (3 Cr. H.)**
This course discusses the definition of the inimitable nature of the Qur'an, (linguistically and syntactically), its aspects, references, and the development in its science and in composing books and studies about the topic. It tries also with suspicions around the Qur'an and their refutation, the old ones as well as the new ones such as the issue of Sarfah.

- (0451707) Thematic Exegesis (3 Cr. H.)**
This course discusses definition, history advantages, types, development, and sources of this kind of exegesis. The unity of each chapter in the Qur'an and how to reveal it. It also will include applied study on chosen subjects and chapters of the Qur'an.
- (0431709) Qur'anic Verses Related to Legislation (3 Cr. H.)**
This course deals with the legislative verses of the Qur'an as referred to/in Islamic resources both the original and the contemporary ones. The course also deal with the importance of this type of knowledge and methodologies of deducing the rulings from the Qur'an and the difference between exegesis of jurisprudence and legislative verses. Also, the course deals with exegete's opinions and their methodology in directing and explaining this sort of verses.
- (0431710) The Qur'anic Recitations (3 Cr. H.)**
This course defines the various readings of the Qur'an, the conditions to accept a reading, its types, and if the sound chain of transmission is enough to accept the reading or if al – tawatur is a condition also, their relation to the various modes (7 ahruf) the origins of the seven reading and the ten readings and the way of its transmission. The course also introduces biographies of the famous scholars of recitation of the Qur'an (al-qurra'), the foundations and methodology of each reading as well as the foundation of the Tasbee', T'sheer and Ifrad. Finally it deals with the interrelation with the exegesis, Tajweed, Qur'anic spelling and the verses counting.
- (0431716) Language and Rhetoric in the Qur'an (3 Cr. H.)**
This course explains the importance of Arabic grammar in interpreting the Qur'an as it was revealed in Arabic and according to their style of speech. The course shows the implications of the various grammatical situations and the alternation in prepositions and how they impact the meanings of the Qur'an .
The course also deals with Qur'anic rhetoric and its definition and its importance in revealing the inimitability of the Qur'an, the synonymousness in the Qur'an, the distinguishing features of the Qur'an and other related topics such as metaphor, metonymy and other rhetorical aspects of the Qur'an.
- (0401717) Modern Trends of Exegesis (3 Cr. H.)**
This course clarifies the most important methodologies of modern Exegetes including: rational, scientific, social, mystic, shi'i, and salafi and salafiin a comparative way and explains its concept, regulations, regulations, advantages and disadvantages and the impact of the interaction with other cultures on each of these trends in a critical method.

(0401719) The Foundations of Research and Edition

(3 Cr. H.)

This course concentrates on the methods of academic research and the foundations of editing texts according to Muslim scholars in comparison to the Western methodology. It teaches the students the practical steps to the writing of his thesis, its steps, and conditions. It also helps teaches him how to choose his title and how to write the proposal. How to use the cards system and how o classify the chapters of his thesis. The course also teaches him how to deal with a manuscript in academic method, choosing, reading and editing. How to choose the copies, which one to rely upon and how to compare and reference them.

0451720 Commentators' Categories (Tabaqat al-Mufasssireen)

(3 Cr. H.)

This course deals with the meaning of ranks, its importance, the origins of this branch of knowledge, the main scholars who studies and compiled, and the historical stages of interpretation since the time of the Prophet throughout the Companions, successors and their Successors. In this course the student will study the biography, methodology, and the books of the famous exegetes in each stage, their methodologies and directions in their books. Also the course deal with the circumstances which surrounded each of these stages and the common features of each stage.

0431736 Analytical Hadith

(3 Cr. H.)

An analytical study will be paid to expressions and explanations of certain Hadiths selected from famous authentic Hadith Books, as well analyzing the text of Hadith (Matn) and the chain of narrators (Sanad) in the way that help the student to reveal the Sanad's issues and sciences as well the Matn's [phrases. Expressions, various narrations, additions in its phrases, deduction narrations' benefits and legislative rulings and belief issues. The study will also learn the student the correct way to read the Hadith.
